

BOLAND PRO10 : CONDITIONS OF PLAY 2023

- **PAIRS** - 2-bowl and any combination.
- **TRIAL ENDS** - A trial end in each direction may be played at the commencement of a game.
- **ORDER OF PLAY** – the team with the bowls nearest to the jack at conclusion of an end will start the next end.
- **BURNT ENDS** – a Jack out of bounds will be replaced on the centre 2m spot (no burnt ends)
- **EACH GAME** - 10 ends.
- **SCORING** – 4, 3, 2, 1 per end which equates to 10 points per end and a total of 100 points for the game. Should a “no shot” situation arise, the points available to bowls in contention shall be shared equally.
- **TIME FRAME** – approximately 1 hour per game.
- **CLUB ENTRIES CLOSING DATE 26 January 2023**
- **BOLAND FINAL ON 3 June 2023:** 12 teams to play in two sections of six (6) each, on a round robin basis. Top two of each section will play crosswise in semi-final, then final and third place.
- **REGIONAL PLAY-OFFS 21 May 2023**– Teams proportional of clubs will qualify for regional final. **Winners** will be the teams with the highest number of points after sectional play. Should 2 Teams finish on the same points total, the winner of the match between those two sides will qualify.
- **NUMBER OF QUALIFIERS PER CLUB** – Allocation by subdistrict before 31 January 2023.
- **NAMES OF QUALIFIERS** from clubs submitted to regional representative before **3 May 2023** in accordance with proportional allocation.
- **CLUB ENTRIES CLOSING DATE 26 January 2023**
- **ENTR FEE R50** to Boland
- **CLUB MATCHES** - at least 4 pairs per club should enter for a club to qualify for play off in your region and preferably play on round robin basis, (3) rounds per day, but 7 rounds per day are possible.
